

Fees 2019-2020

The REGISTRATION FEE for all classes is \$80 for the 2019-2020 School Year. This fee is required at the time of registration. The registration fee is used to help pay for program expenses such as supplies throughout the school year. An *advance tuition deposit* equal to the monthly tuition rate is due within thirty days of the child's acceptance and is one's financial commitment to hold a child's place until school begins. The advance tuition deposit is applied toward *Annual Tuition*.

Annual Tuition is prorated on an eleven payment basis. The advance tuition deposit is the first payment. The remaining ten payments are due monthly, August through May. Monthly payments are due by the 15th of each month or a late fee of \$20 will be assessed. A full month's tuition is due regardless of the number of days attended each month.

PRORATED MONTHLY TUITION: \$123 per month for the 2 day classes 9AM-12PM Tuesday, Thursday

\$163 per month for 3 day classes 9AM-12PM Monday, Wednesday, Friday

\$245 per month for the 5 day classes 9AM-12PM Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, Friday

Annual Tuition and Extended Care fees are used to pay for our program expenses, operating expenses, and staff expenses.

Program expenses include such things as:

- classroom art supplies
- curriculum guides/books
- teaching and learning materials
- cleaning supplies
- special programs and field trips
 - * Programs and trips are held throughout the school year.

Examples of some of these special activities held during a typical year include:

All children attend Music, Library and Creative Movement one time each week, throughout the year. Chapel is held daily in the St. Francis Children's Chapel by the Director, and twice a month by a priest.

Children attend TRI-ART programs at the Clemson University Brook Center throughout the year.

Operating Expenses include such things as:

- office supplies, equipment, furniture, and playground maintenance
- utilities, building usage and repairs
- National Association of Episcopal School membership fees

Staff Expenses include items such as:

- staff salaries
- payroll expenses
- substitute pay
- training and workshops
- custodial services

EXTENDED CARE is offered to children enrolled in classes on the days they are in attendance.

* Children must be at least two years old to participate in Extended Care. *

SCHEDULED: Early Morning Care-Block A (7:30-8:45a.m.) costs \$18.50 per day of the week enrolled, per month.

After School Care–Block B (12:00-2:00p.m.) costs \$30.00 per day of the week enrolled, per month. After School Care-Block C (2:00-5:30p.m.) costs \$50.50 per day of the week enrolled, per month.

AS-NEEDED: Block A - \$7.25 per day, Block B - \$11.75 per day, Block C - \$20.50 per day.

Parents who desire extended care on an AS-NEEDED basis may sign-up at least a day in advance for an

additional daily fee, if space is available.

FULL TIME OPTION: Children who are enrolled in a class meeting five days per week can stay full time on school days, from 7:30a.m. to 5:30p.m., for an annual rate of \$5965. This Full Time Option covers class tuition and Extended Care fees (Blocks A, B & C). It is prorated on an eleven payment basis. The advance tuition payment of \$245 is the first payment. The remaining Annual Tuition will be paid in ten equal payments of \$572. The August through May payments are due by the 15th of each month or a late fee of \$20 will be assessed. A full month's payment is due regardless of the number of days attended each month.
