Sunday School Leader/Volunteer

A Sunday School Leader/Volunteer role consists of a one month every Sunday commitment to be alternating monthly between other Leaders/Volunteers for the entirety of the program season. The rotation of monthly Sundays is to allow leaders/volunteers to attend church services and to allow flexibility with personal schedules. Ideally, the Sunday School schedule will be issued in August and cover the duration of the program year with the notion of possible changes due to unforeseen occurrences that may arise.

Lesson plans, activities and guidelines will be organized by the Parish Life Coordinator and emailed to the leaders each week as well as having the Sunday School rooms prepped and set up.

Leaders/Volunteers simply need to be familiar with the lesson plans and show up with a smile! It is appreciated that Sunday School leaders/volunteers arrive in the room by 10:15 am ready to greet the attendees as they arrive. Sunday school begins at 10:30 am and will last approximately 45 mins. Sunday School participants will go to the service at the Peace to join their families or whom they wish to sit with.

Sunday School offers the opportunity to teach our children and youth about Jesus with age appropriate lessons. This is a vital part of our church in order to help develop spiritual growth and belonging for our younger parishioners. This is a great way to get to know our children, youth and their families. Your time and willingness is appreciated.
